The Town has engaged the services of VDA Architecture to help us formalize a vision, concept plans and budget for the Proposed Health, Wellness & Aquatic Centre.

The study involved research, and discussions with the aquatic centre feasibility working group, recreation personnel and Council.

So that we could be sure that the plan would be sensitive to the needs of the community, one of the next stages will be to host an open house to present the feasibility study that has been developed over the last year.

## THE TOWN OF PRINCETON WELCOMES JESSICA BLUE

The Town of Princeton has partnered with the British Columbia Conservation Foundation to create a new WildSafeBC community coordinator position for Princeton. Jessica Blue is the new coordinator and has just completed a week of intensive training in Kamloops. This is the first year that the town has had its very own coordinator strictly working for Princeton.

By implementing this program we hope to meet the goals of:

- Increased public safety,
- A reduction in the avoidable destruction of wildlife,
- Decreased losses to property, crops or livestock, and a,
- Better understanding by the public of our roles in complex ecosystems.

To put it simply we will be “keeping wildlife wild and communities safe.”
